

## COLORADO MANDATORY DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

### Education and Experience

Kandace Cahill earned her Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree from Southwest Acupuncture College in August 2006. This four-year program consists of 3,000 hours of didactic and clinical education. She was certified as a Diplomate in Oriental Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in October 2006, which includes certification in acupuncture, Chinese herbology, and Clean Needle Technique. After graduation, Kandace completed an internship at the International Acupuncture Training Centre in Beijing, China, receiving advanced certification in clinical Chinese herbology. Kandace also received training in massage therapy, having graduated from the Massage Therapy Training Institute in Kansas City, Missouri in 1994. She has operated a private massage practice since that time, and currently offers massage therapy in conjunction with her Chinese medicine practice.

Kandace's training includes adjunctive therapies such as moxibustion, tui na, acupressure, cupping, auriculotherapy, electrical stimulation (e-stim), and dietary/lifestyle recommendations.

Kandace is a member of the Acupuncture Association of Colorado, the American Association of Oriental Medicine, and the American Acupuncture Council. She is a licensed acupuncturist in Colorado, and previously held a massage therapy license in Missouri. None of these licenses, certificates, or registrations has ever been suspended or revoked.

This clinic complies with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Colorado Department of Health, including the proper cleaning and sterilization of needles and the sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sterilized needles are utilized.
